



RESTAURANT LA PERGOLA FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the opening days and times of the restaurant?

We are open only for dinner - Tuesday through Saturday.

The restaurant opens at 7:30pm. The bar is open for an aperitif from 6:30pm, but no dinner is served at the bar. We assign tables to our guests for the entire evening so that they may relax and fully enjoy their fine dining experience. The last order is at 11:30pm.

Is the restaurant open all year round?

We are closed for 3 weeks in January and 3 weeks in August.

What are the opening days and times of the reservation office?

The reservations office is open from Monday through Friday 10:30am-6:30pm (CET/Rome Time).

How can I request a dinner reservation?

You can access our online reservation system on the restaurant's webpage <u>https://romecavalieri.com/la-pergola/</u>. Please note that currently you are able to book only 4-5 months in advance. We usually open bookings farther in the future at the beginning of each month.

A credit card guarantee is required when making a reservation. Changes and cancellations are accepted up to 72 hours from the dinner date and time. Any changes or cancellations less than 72 hours prior to the reserved date and time will incur a charge (please read the Reservations Terms & Conditions carefully when booking). Once the reservation is completed, you will receive a confirmation email. Please make sure to check your SPAM folder since the automated confirmation e-mail may be filtered by some e-mail servers.

How far in advance do you suggest making a reservation?

We suggest to book a few weeks in advance. On our online reservation system the table availability is always up-to-date.

Do you have a dress code?

For gentlemen, a jacket is required, although a tie is not necessary. There are no specific requirements for ladies, but keep in mind the restaurant is guite formal.

Covid-19

Our restaurant operates in accordance with the Italian government health requirements, which are continuously monitored and updated.

As required by the Italian government, in the restaurant and in all public spaces of the hotel, social distancing of 1 meter is requested and all guests must wear a face mask, whenever they are not seated at the table (e.g. when going to the toilet).

Several hand sanitizers are available in the restaurant.

Can you accommodate guests with allergies or celiac disease?

The Maître will be happy to guide you to the most appropriate choices on the menu, keeping in mind your specific dietary needs. However, we do prepare all the dishes on the menu in the same kitchen and cannot, therefore, guarantee 100% that your dish will remain uncontaminated.





Can you accommodate vegetarians or vegans?

Our cuisine is based on meat and fish, combined with vegetables.

We do not have a specific vegetarian or vegan menu, but can prepare vegetarian or vegan dishes upon request. Upon booking, kindly indicate what is to be excluded between meat, fish, seafood, eggs and dairy.

Do you accept children?

Children are welcome in our dining room as long as they are supervised at all times. Our guests expect to find a quiet, elegant ambiance to complement the refined dining experience for which our restaurant is renowned. We do not serve a specific children's menu, but simple dishes can be prepared upon request.

Are you able to accommodate disabled guests?

The restaurant is entirely wheelchair accessible.

Do you accept pets?

Although we love animals, pets are not allowed at La Pergola.

What is the price of the gourmet menu?

The price of the 10 course menu is Euro 290 per person, the price of the 7 course menu is Euro 250 per person.

The menu is subject to change without prior notice and dishes may change due to the seasonality of ingredients. We are flexible in accommodating any specific needs in case of vegetarians, allergies, religious restrictions etc.

Do you also have an à la carte menu?

Do you accept groups?

We strive to offer the best dining experience for our guests and for this reason, we can accommodate a party of maximum 16 guests.

For parties of 6 or more guests our Chef suggests to experience his gourmet menu. Of course, we are flexible with specific needs for guests with special dietary requirements.

For parties between 10 and 16 guests we will reserve the private dining area of the restaurant with an imperial table and decoration and a supplement of Euro 500.

The guests are welcomed with Champagne, followed by Chef Beck's tasting menu and our Sommelier's wine pairing. The price of this 10 course menu with 4 wines is Euro 950 per couple, whereas the price of the 7 course menu with 3 wines is Euro 800 per couple, both options include bottled mineral water and coffee.
